



Bracklyn Wind Farm

UPDATE

Bracklyn Wind Farm project is a wind energy development of 9 wind turbines with a typical output of 5-6 megawatts per turbine of renewable energy - enough to provide approximately 38,300* Irish households with green energy every year.

The Bracklyn Wind farm project were notified of grant of permission on the 11th of July 2022.

What's Next for the wind farm?

As always, the Bracklyn wind farm team will keep you up to date with current information on the project.

The next step for this project is submitting a grid application in September 2022. The grid operator will notify Bracklyn Wind Farm Q1 - Q4 2023 with grid connection delivery timeline.
