Bracklyn Wind Farm Project is a proposed wind energy development of approximately 11 wind turbines with a typical output of 5-6 megawatts per turbine of renewable energy - enough to provide approximately 46,900* Irish households with green energy every year. The proposed development is within the townland of Bracklin, Co. Westmeath.

A met mast will also be installed on the site in the coming months to measure the wind resource. The proposed development is being designed to the latest best industry standards and we are appealing to local residents to have their say at an early stage of the development so as to maximise the project benefits to the neighbouring community.
